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1. Перечень компетенций с указанием этапов их формирования в процессе освоения ППСЗ в рамках учебной дисциплины

Перечень и содержание компетенций указаны в рабочей программе дисциплины.

Основными этапами формирования указанных компетенций при изучении студентами дисциплины являются:

- начальный - на этом этапе формируются знаниевые и инструментальные основы компетенции, осваиваются основные категории, формируются базовые умения. В целом знания и умения носят репродуктивный характер. Студент воспроизводит термины, факты, методы, понятия, принципы и правила; решает учебные задачи по образцу. Если студент отвечает этим требованиям можно говорить об освоении им порогового уровня компетенции;

- основной этап - знания, умения, навыки, обеспечивающие формирование компетенции, значительно возрастают, но еще не достигают итоговых значений. На этом этапе студент осваивает аналитические действия с предметными знаниями по конкретной дисциплине, способен самостоятельно решать учебные задачи, внося коррективы в алгоритм действий, осуществляя соморегуляцию в ходе работы, переносить знания и умения на новые условия. Успешное прохождение этого этапа позволяет достичь повышенного уровня сформированности компетенции;

- завершающий этап - на этом этапе студент достигает итоговых показателей по заявленной компетенции, то есть осваивает весь необходимый объем знаний, овладевает всеми умениями и навыками в сфере заявленной компетенции. Он способен использовать эти знания, умения, навыки при решении задач повышенной сложности и в нестандартных условиях. По результатам этого этапа студент демонстрирует продвинутый уровень сформированности компетенции.

2. Описание показателей и критериев оценивания компетенций на различных этапах их формирования, описание шкал оценивания

2.1. Критерии определения сформированности компетенций на различных этапах их формирования

Основной критериев для оценивания сформированности компетенций является демонстрируемый обучаемым уровень самостоятельности в применении полученных в ходе изучения учебной дисциплины знаний, умений и навыков.

Тематика ролевых игр

5. Invite your friend to your new flat and show it to him (her).
6. You have to decide the problem: to buy or not to buy a new flat. Discuss it with your husband (wife).
7. You are a first year student of teaching college. Now you live far from your family. Your mother is asking you about your new daily routine.
8. Your friend and you are students. But you live and study in different towns. Discuss your daily routines and compare them.
9. You have acquainted with a girl (a boy). Ask each other about your hobbies.
10. You hate sports, but your brother is a football fan and he wants you to join him to the stadium to see a football match. What will you do?
11. Your friend believes that any hobby helps to know a lot of new information and it is very important to have a hobby. But you have a different opinion. You think that a hobby is only for children and seniors, but adults have no time to deal with these stupid things.
12. Imagine you are interviewing an animal protection activist.
13. You are a green party activist, but your speech partner thinks that ecological problems are not so important.

23. You are participants of telebridge about Russia, GB and the USA. Each of you has to tell about your country.
24. You are a guide for Russian students. You are going sightseeing around New York.

25. You've come back from a trip to Washington, D.C. Tell your family about the sights you visited there.

Концепция игры и роли участников

В ходе проведения ролевой (деловой) игры студенты работают в парах и выполняют предложенную им роль.

После проведения фрагмента урока происходит его обсуждение. Анализируется полнота высказанных аргументов в пользу предложенной в ролевой игре позиции.

Ожидаемый результат

В ходе ролевой (деловой) игры студент должен продемонстрировать:

- знание лексических единиц по предложенной теме,
- умение выстраивать стратегию диалога,
- владение речевыми формулами, выражающими различные эмоции (удивление, несогласие, уточнение и др.);
- умение начать и закончить коммуникацию;
- умение аргументировать выбранную позицию;
- проявлять толерантность по отношению к другой позиции.

Критерии оценки учебных действий студентов в ходе ролевой игры.

Оценка	Характеристики ответа студента
Отлично	Правильно выстроена стратегия диалога. Студент сыграл свою роль только на английском языке, использовал соответствующие лексические единицы и речевые формулы, адекватно реагировал на слова оппонента по игре, умело отстаивал свою позицию, был логичен и убедителен. Поставленная в начале игры перед студентом коммуникативная задача была выполнена полностью.
Хорошо	Направление стратегии диалога было выбрано в целом верно. Студент говорил только на английском языке, но допускал несущественные ошибки, в речи присутствовали паузы. Большинство реакций на слова оппонента были адекватными. Смог отстоять практически все свои тезисы. В целом поставленная коммуникативная задача была выполнена.
Удовлетворительно	Допускались неточности в выборе стратегии диалога. Лексическое наполнение речи было довольно скудным. Не все реакции на слова оппонента были верными. Иногда допускались переходы на русский язык. В речи было много пауз, неточностей. В целом задача была выполнена.
Неудовлетворительно	Не выполнены требования, предъявляемые к знаниям, оцениваемым на "удовлетворительно".

Whether you're travelling to the islands or the mountains of Thailand, you're likely to spend at least one night in its capital city on the way. Bangkok might be noisy and polluted but it's also an exciting city with plenty of things to see and do. Why not make it a longer stay?

Where to stay

The Khao San Road was a famous traveller spot even before Leonardo di Caprio's character in the film *The Beach* stayed there. But it's noisy, not very pretty and not very Thai. It's not as convenient for the main tourist sites, but it has a Skytrain station so you can be at the Grand Palace in 20 minutes.

How to get around

Bangkok's traffic can be a nightmare. Sure, you can easily take a taxi – if you want to spend hours stuck in traffic jams – but there are two much better ways to get around the city. To explore the temples and historical sites, catch an express boat river taxi or a longtail boat along the Chao Phraya river and the canals. For the modern part of the city, the Skytrain is a fast, cheap way to travel from the river to the shopping malls and nightlife of Sukhumvit, and the famous Chatuchak street market.

Where to eat

The simple answer is: everywhere! Thai street food is among the best in the world, and for around \$5 you can eat a filling and delicious meal. Some food stands have little plastic seats where you can sit and eat and they cook the same dish over and over, like fried chicken on rice

or Pad Thai noodles. Head for Chinatown – Yaowarat Street – and choose whatever looks most interesting from the many excellent Chinese and Thai restaurants and food stands.

What to do

After you’ve seen the main sites like the Giant Buddha at the temple of Wat Pho and the spectacular Grand Palace, and shopped at Chatuchak market, check out the snake farm and watch the live snake show. You can even touch a snake yourself if you want to!

Критерии оценки:

- оценка «отлично» выставляется студенту, если он набрал более 90 % от возможного числа первичных баллов за выполнение заданий к экзамену;
- оценка «хорошо» выставляется студенту, если он набрал более 75 % от возможного числа первичных баллов за выполнение заданий к экзамену;
- оценка «удовлетворительно» выставляется студенту, если он набрал более 60 % от возможного числа первичных баллов за выполнение заданий к экзамену;
- оценка «неудовлетворительно» выставляется студенту, если он набрал менее 60 % от возможного числа первичных баллов за выполнение заданий к экзамену.

4. Методические материалы, определяющие процедуры оценивания знаний, умений, навыков и (или) опыта деятельности, характеризующих этапы формирования компетенций

Контроль и оценка результатов освоения учебной дисциплины осуществляется преподавателем в процессе проведения практических занятий, тестирования, а также выполнения обучающимися индивидуальных заданий, проектов, исследований.

Оценка знаний, умений, навыков, характеризующая этапы формирования компетенций по дисциплине осуществляется в ходе текущего и промежуточного контроля.

Текущий контроль организуется в формах:

- устного опроса (собеседования, ролевой игры);
- проверки письменных заданий (эссе);
- тестирования;
- оценки результатов предметной деятельности студента.

Промежуточный контроль осуществляется по темам дисциплины в других формах контроля (контрольные работы) в 3, 4, 5 семестрах.

Итоговый контроль по дисциплине «Иностранный язык» проводится в форме дифференцированного зачета (6 семестр) и экзамена (7 семестр).

Оценивание знаний, умений, навыков и (или) опыта деятельности должно носить комплексный, системный характер – с учетом как места дисциплины в ППСЗ, так и содержательных и смысловых внутренних связей.
